**"By the Book" - Repair Tips and
Techniques**

Many of us have shelves of horological books, but how often do we use them? Each issue, we will feature a repair tip or historical tidbit taken from a common reference book. These tips are offered for informational purposes only. Chapter 47 or its board do not endorse any of the tips or techniques offered herein.

From "K&D Staking Tools and How to Use Them":

"Staking tool punches, like all watchmakers' tools, are precision made to benefit skilled workmen and must be used with care. Each staking tool punch was primarily designed for a specific type of work and careful handling must be exercised to avoid breakage and unnecessary wear. A few 'do's' and 'don't's' are listed below to assist you in properly using your Staking Tool punches and stumps."

"Always use a brass hammer"
"Light tapping"
"American made balance staffs are harder"
Check periodically for rust:
"Check punches for wear"
